




Bladensburg officials & employees,

I want to thank Purnell Hall, the Public works team, the Town Council, Mr. Moss & all of the other town officials & town employees who helped get the leaf vacuum and leaf vacuum service for Bladensburg. The leaf vacuum makes it so much easier for town residents to put leaves in the front yard by the curb for pick up and it helps keep the yards, streets and curb areas clean. I think it is even easier for public works to pick up leaves this way. In the past some residents have left leaves in the yard all year which kills the grass and provides a nesting area for rodents. The leaf vacuum encourages people to get rid of their leaves with the easier method of the leaf vacuum.

There are still some residents who apparently have not gotten the instructions for the new leaf vacuum procedures. I see some still putting leaves in plastic bags and putting the plastic bags at the curb. I would ask the public works and the town to find a way to help residents to find a way to get rid of these leaves in plastic bags, otherwise those plastic bags of leaves will sit in the yard another year. I know the leaf vacuum procedures have been put on cable TV, town emails and in the town newsletter, but still there are some people who apparently haven't got the instructions. A few people even pile the leaves in the street. If people are worried about cars blocking pick up area perhaps they can put a note on a traffic cone for leaf pick up that morning. I am asking Public works, and the code dept. to hand out flyers in English & Spanish to those who are not following proper procedures. Mr. Moss can you send out another email to everyone with complete instructions and pick up days and ask that everyone pass the word to their neighbors. Let us know how residents and the Citizens Committee can help make the leaf vacuum process work better.

Please continue to vacuum leaves as long as possible this season as leaves are still falling from the trees. Also please let us know a week ahead of when the last leaf pickup is so we don't end up with piles of leaves left in front of houses. Again I want to thank everyone who helped provide leaf vacuum service to Bladensburg. It is a good sound to hear the leaf vacuum coming down the street. I was even surprised that it rained the other day and public works still found a way to pick up the leaves. Please let the public works team know how much we appreciate their hard work in keeping Bladensburg clean and beautiful.

*Removal of all saplings and juvenile trees as well as large dead trees in zoned work area.

*Clean fence line of debris by shearing and weed eat back growth in the same back section.

*Removal of all down large tree trunks and chipping smaller debris on site.

*All other site debris will not be removed by Brickman. Other site debris include tire and other trash.

Work will be performed on a day rate. (A minimum of week is work required to start the work.) We feel that the work will take more than a week.
